

Reminders

• **Telephone numbers:** Have you recently changed your telephone number? Call PHA at 561-0720 extension 224 or extension 229 to update your number in our records.

Enjoy this time of year and remember the following rules & regulations:

- Yards: Maintain a nice yard around your apartment by keeping it picked up and free of debris, toys, garbage and cigarette butts.
- Heaters: Keep all windows and doors closed during cold weather and make sure all heaters are clean. Dirt and dust in the heaters stop the units from heating your apartment properly.
- Cars/Trucks: Register your vehicle at the PHA office and place the sticker on the backside of the rearview mirror. This helps us to identify the owner in case the vehicle needs to be moved for snow removal.
