JULY 30TH IS FAST APPROACHING

The smoke free housing addendum applies to all Employees and Residents of Plattsburgh Housing Authority (PHA) and is incorporated into the Lease with All Residents as a Lease Addendum. The policy becomes effective July 30, 2018. Refusal or failure to sign this addendum shall constitute a violation of Section 27, of the PHA lease.

Definition of Smoking.: The "smoking" means inhaling, exhaling, breathing, burning, carrying, possessing or disposing any lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe, water pipe or bong, hookah or other tobacco product or similar lighted product in any manner or in any form; including ecigarettes and vaporizers.

If you are interested in quitting smoking there is help. Plattsburgh Housing Authority is offering a FREE 7week program on Tuesdays from 1:30 PM to 2:30 PM from February 20th to April 3rd at the Russell H. Barnard Community Room (46 Flynn Avenue, Plattsburgh).
